

TERMINAL LOBBY EXPANSION

FACT SHEET

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Terminal Lobby Expansion will increase the current lobby space by 175,000 square feet and renovate another 191,000 square feet. The terminal was built in 1982 and designed to accommodate approximately 2.8 million passengers a year. In 2022, the Airport served nearly 48 million passengers. The TLE is the Airport's signature Destination CLT project, a \$3.1 billion capital investment in capacity enhancements.

ARTWORK:

In partnership with Arts & Science Council, eight artists were selected to create pieces for the lobby expansion and renovation.

SPECIAL FEATURES:

The renovation will include a 146,000-square-foot canopy to protect passengers dropping off in front of the terminal, larger checkpoints with greater capacity to process passengers through security, more baggage claim carousels, additional concessions, Queens Court with additional seating for customers and overhead and subterranean walkways, allowing CLT visitors to bypass upper and lower level Airport roadway traffic.

NOTABLE INFORMATION:

- \cdot Expansion and renovation of the basement, baggage claim and ticketing levels
- \cdot Consolidation of five security checkpoints into three larger, more efficient checkpoints
- Two pedestrian overhead walkways that will connect the new mezzanine level of the terminal to the Hourly Deck
